HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RELEASE IN MATTAWA

The situation is under control. No one has been injured and there is currently no need for the public to evacuate.

MOSES LAKE – Emergency responders are currently working at a hazardous materials release at the Port of Mattawa, 22801 Rd U-SW, Mattawa, about 2 miles northwest of the city of Mattawa.

Emergency responders were notified around 10:00 a.m. of the release of *ammonium hydroxide* inside a building which serves as part of the sewage treatment plant. The situation is under control. No one has been injured and there is currently no need for the public to evacuate.

Grant County Fire District 8, Washington Department of Ecology and Grant County Emergency Management are working together to bring this incident to a conclusion.
