

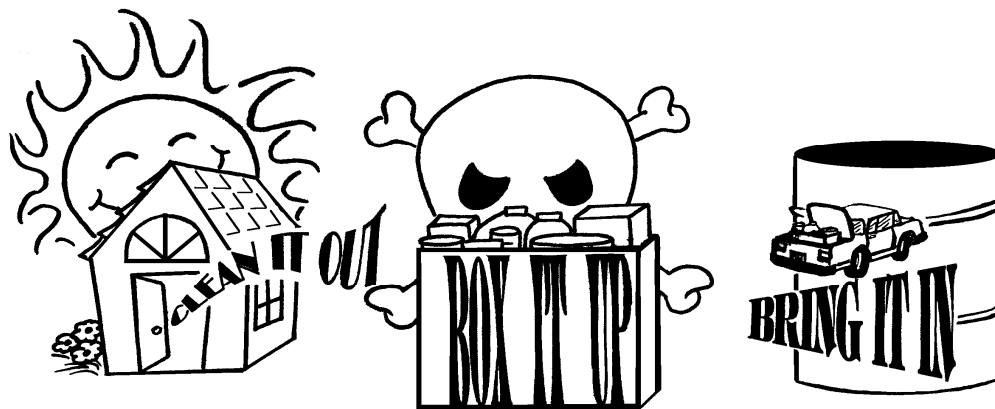

BRING: Oil based paint, stains, thinners, household batteries, solvents, antifreeze, brake fluid, contaminated used motor oil, cleaning products, spot removers, insecticides, weed killers, fluorescent tubes, swimming pool and hobby chemicals

DON'T BRING: latex paint, uncontaminated used motor oil, propane tanks, automotive batteries, agriculture waste, commercial waste, explosives, ammunition, flares, asbestos, radioactive material, cylinders, Poison A gases, leaking containers, containers larger than **5 gallons**, white goods (appliances, televisions), refrigerants and refrigerant compressors, and medicines

Waste not accepted from farms, businesses, agencies, governments, special districts, and school districts!
